

Flagstaff Archers Membership Application

Flagstaff Archers is a non-profit club ran solely by club member volunteers. The club maintains an archery range at Fort Tuthill in partnership with Coconino County Parks & Recreation. Membership to Flagstaff Archers includes access to the archery range featuring a sight in range with distances of 15 to 80 yards, a 15-station 3D course, picnic tables and several club events.

Flagstaff Archers hosts and sponsors various member events throughout the year including poker shoots, night shoots, a ladies night shoot, a turkey shoot, archery league and the Max Hamilton 3D shoot. Flagstaff Archers also provides volunteer opportunities such as the Special Archers Challenge, an event hosted by Flagstaff Archers for individuals with disabilities.

Flagstaff Archers strongly believes in supporting the archery and hunting community. Membership dues not only help maintain the range but also to support our partner organizations and programs including the Basic & Intermediate Archery Clinics hosted by Coconino County Parks and Rec, local Hunter Education Courses and more!

Things to know!

- A family membership is \$100.00 and includes (2) adults and children under 18 years of age. Children over the age of 18 must purchase an individual pass.
- An individual pass is \$75.00 and is for (1) person. This pass cannot be shared.
- Yearly memberships are for 12 months of access from the day you register. Please keep a reminder to renew your membership a year from when you register. This will help avoid your card from being deactivated.
- De-activated access cards may take up to two weeks to be reinstated.
- All (shooting) guests must purchase a day pass from the Coconino County Parks and Rec office by calling 928-679-8000. Guests that have not purchased a day pass may not shoot at the range.
- All members must have their membership card on them while using the range. You may be asked to produce this and verify your membership by range officials.
- Broadheads are not allowed at the range (ever). No exception!
- When entering and leaving the range, please ensure the main access gate is closed. This protects our range from poachers and limits the safety liability for our club.
- Flagstaff Archers conducts a member meeting every other month. We encourage all members to be actively involved and volunteer for events.
